Note Circular amending the sanitary control directives for travelers entering and leaving Guinea

In application of the state emergency on Health and the evolution of the epidemiological data of COVID-19, humanity is going through an upsurge of new cases. Many variants circulate around the world including in some neighboring countries among the most virulent are:

Alpha, Beta, Gamma and Delta.

This situation risks to cause a third wave in countries where collective immunity has not yet been achieved by the low vaccination coverage rate, including the Republic of Guinea with 4%.

Faced with this situation, the Republic of Guinea like other countries, has updated its health control Protocol: . 14, 17

For travelers I.

- 1. All travelers from foreign countries will be subject to strict control of their COVID-19 RT-PCR test result;
- 2. Among these travelers will be authorized to return to their residence only those whose result of the COVID-19 RT-PCR test is negative;
- 3. For special reasons (repatriation and evacuation), people entering who do not have a COVID-19 RT-PCR result will receive a COVID-19 RT-PCR sample at their arrival and will be isolated at their expense.

For travelers from countries where the variants flowing II.

- 1. These travelers must have a result of RT PCR COVID-19 negative less than 72 hours at the start;
- 2. They should compulsory do a second COVID-19 RT-PCR test at their own expense and upon arrival at Conakry airport, at the land and sea borders;
- 3. They will be subjected to a systematic control during their stay in Guinea;
- 4. The ANSS in collaboration with the beneficiary services will ensure the compliance with health protocol (wearing bibs, washing hands and physical distancing);
- 5. Invite citizens or experts from countries where these variants circulate to be vaccinated two (2) weeks before their arrival in Guinea.

NB:

1. Authorized vaccins in Guinea are: Sputnik V; Slnopharm; Slnovac; Astra Zeneca; Moderna, Pflzer and Johnson & Jonhson.

2. Obtaining entry visas to the Republic of Guinea is conditional on compliance These provisions are flexible and may be revised as the COVID-19 disease with these guidelines.
